

HOT WEATHER

The forecast maximum temperature referred to in this section is that issued by the Bureau of Meteorology (BOM) Port Adelaide at 2:30pm

If the forecast maximum temperature for 4.30pm is 36 degrees or above the meet will be cancelled. This is for the safety of athletes and volunteers who are setting up.

WET WEATHER

If there is significant rainfall the committee will make a decision to cancel the meet for athlete safety.

If there is some lighter rain the committee may modify the meet allowing for safe completion of events.

THUNDER

Sports in Australia follow the 30-30 rule.

By the time the flash-to-bang count approaches 30 seconds, all individuals should already be inside a safe shelter. Wait at least 30 minutes after the last sound (thunder) or observation of lightning and ensure conditions are completely safe before leaving shelter to resume activities.

If thunder storms are forecast on BOM Port Adelaide the committee will make a decision on cancelling the meet with athlete safety in mind.

However if the meet goes ahead the 30-30 rule stated above will be followed.
